Mass time change effective November 28

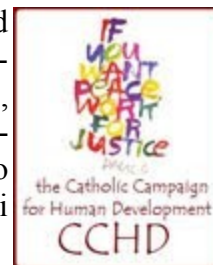
Beginning on Sunday, November 28, the first Sunday of Advent the 11:30 am Mass will become the 11:45 am Mass. This is a permanent change in our Mass schedule.

This change is being made to accommodate the Religious Education classes and will allow the classes to meet for a full hour on Sunday mornings. R.E. Classes will begin at 10:15 am as usual.

Currently, six Catholic parishes are participating members of **FACE Maui**. **ROC Kalihi** is a newer group, comprised of Kalihi Valley residents' young and old, to include parishioners of Our Lady of the Mount. Their common mission is to repair their community by ridding it of drugs, trash and graffiti thereby restoring Kalihi Valley to what it was "back in the day."

Solemnity of Christ the King

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

Today's Gospel reading presents a very humbling pic-
 ture of the Lord in Calvary. Sentenced and con-
 demned to death, Jesus, an innocent victim, is cruci-
 fied between two thieves.

Even as the crowds jeer at his inability to save him-
 self, Jesus forgives and saves the criminal who ac-
 knowledges his wrongdoing and declares Jesus'
 innocence. Like this repentant criminal, we have
 the confidence to draw close to the King because
 he is merciful and he has saved us by his cross.

Let us recognize Jesus, the "wounded healer". He
 is an innocent man being led like a lamb to the
 slaughter, God's "Suffering Servant" who is
 pierced for our offenses and by whose stripes "we
 were healed" (Is. 53).

The world is full of people wishing to be remembered,

 remember and care for them the we help to build God's
 Kingdom here on earth. As we remember and recog-
