

Last October 26 to 27, Frs. Gregorio, Clifford and I went to Honolulu for a Seminar/Workshop on the Roman Missal, Third edition. Deacons Jerry and Julio were also present. It was a way for us clergy to know, understand and appreciate the changes. We have a year to prepare ourselves for the implementation.

I would like to reprint in this column what the Committee on Divine Worship said (August-September 20110 Issue).

"In early August 2010, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops received the final text of the third edition of the Roman Missal from the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments (CDWDS), along with approved adaptations and the proper texts and calendar for the dioceses of the United states of America. After consulting with the committee on Divine Worship, Francis Cardinal George, OMI, USCCB President, announced the implementation date of the new Roman Missal as the First Sunday of Advent, November 27, 2011."

I hope that as a parish community we will all welcome the Third Edition of the Roman Missal. God bless you,


Mahalo for your thoughtfulness.
