Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

After our Advent preparation and the festive weeks of the Christmas season, we are back to Ordinary Time in the calendar of the Church. The liturgical themes of this season focus on the proclamation and the application of the Good News of the Lord in the daily routine of our lives. In this Sunday's Gospel we are being led to the call of the Lord, to put our undivided attention on Him: to love Him more dearly, to follow Him more closely and to serve Him more faithfully.

According to the Ordo this Tuesday, January 18 begins the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. We will pray for this intention in all of our masses and prayers. The birth of Martin Luther King, Jr. will be celebrated on Monday, January 17. Let us pray for the end of racial discrimination. Also on Saturday, January 22, is the anniversary of the Supreme Court decision, Roe vs. Wade (1973), "this day shall be observed in all dioceses of the United States as a particular day of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life."

Let us pray:

O God who art peace everlasting, whose chosen reward is the gift of peace and who hast taught us that the peace-makers are thy children, pour thy peace into our souls, that everything discordant may utterly vanish, and all that makes for peace be sweet to us forever. Amen. (Mozarabic sacramentary, before 700 AD)
