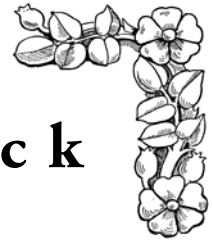

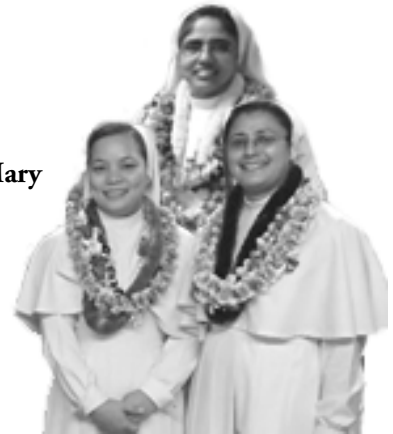

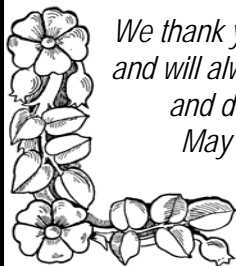

Peace in the Risen Lord!

The Ascension marked the end of the earthly life of Jesus. Jesus is exalted in the glory of the Father. He is exalted because of his obedience. The ancient Christian hymn expresses it well: "Jesus humbled himself, accepting death, death on the cross. Because of this, God highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee would bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father."



Obedience is the test of authentic childhood before God who is 'Abba'. Jesus said, "My food is to do the will of the one who sent me."
