One of the characteristics of Jesus is that he loved to eat. He loved to break bread together with others. In today's Gospel of the multiplication of the loaves, Jesus took bread and distributed it to the people who were hungry and had been following him. The early Christians were also known as a community who breaks bread. They celebrated the central mystery of the faith in the bread, broken, blessed and shared in the Eucharistic meal. 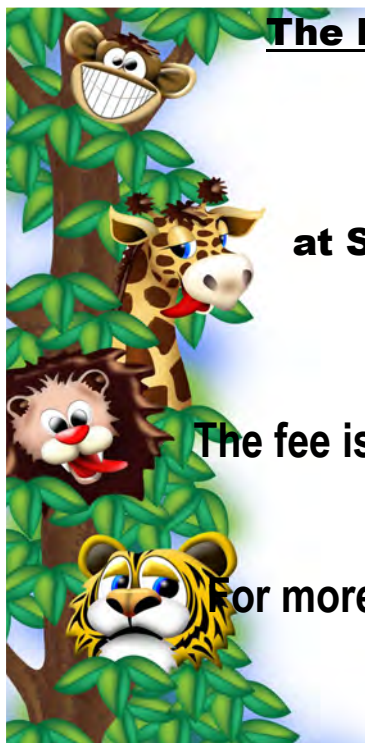
