Chrism Mass Held on Big Island



The Chrism Mass for the all Big Island parishes was held on Thursday, February 28 at St. Joseph Parish.

The Mass of Chrism happens only once a year. It is one of the most solemn and significant liturgies of our church. During the Mass, Bishop Silva blesses the oil of catechumens, the oil of the sick, and the oil of chrism. We use the first for adult catechumens and infants, the second for anointing the sick, and the sacred oil of chrism for baptism, confirmation, the ordination of priests, and the consecration of altars. All three are olive oil; the chrism oil is unique because of the addition of fragrant balsam.

Pastor's Corner

5th Sunday of Lent

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace!

In our Gospel for this Sunday we see Jesus challenging those who challenged him: "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her (referring to the woman caught in the act of adultery)." No one met the challenge of Jesus.

Here, Jesus condemns no one, not the woman nor those who challenged him. But he tells her, "Go, and from now on do not sin anymore."

Lent is a good time for us to be reminded of the letter of Saint Paul to the Galatians, "Now the works of the flesh are plain: fornication, impurity, licentiousness, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger, selfishness dissension, factions, envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things shall not inherit the Kingdom of God."

As St. Paul warns he also affirms, "Where sin increased, grace abounded all the more." But to do its work grace must uncover sin so as to convert our hearts and bestow on us "righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." (CCC 1848).


