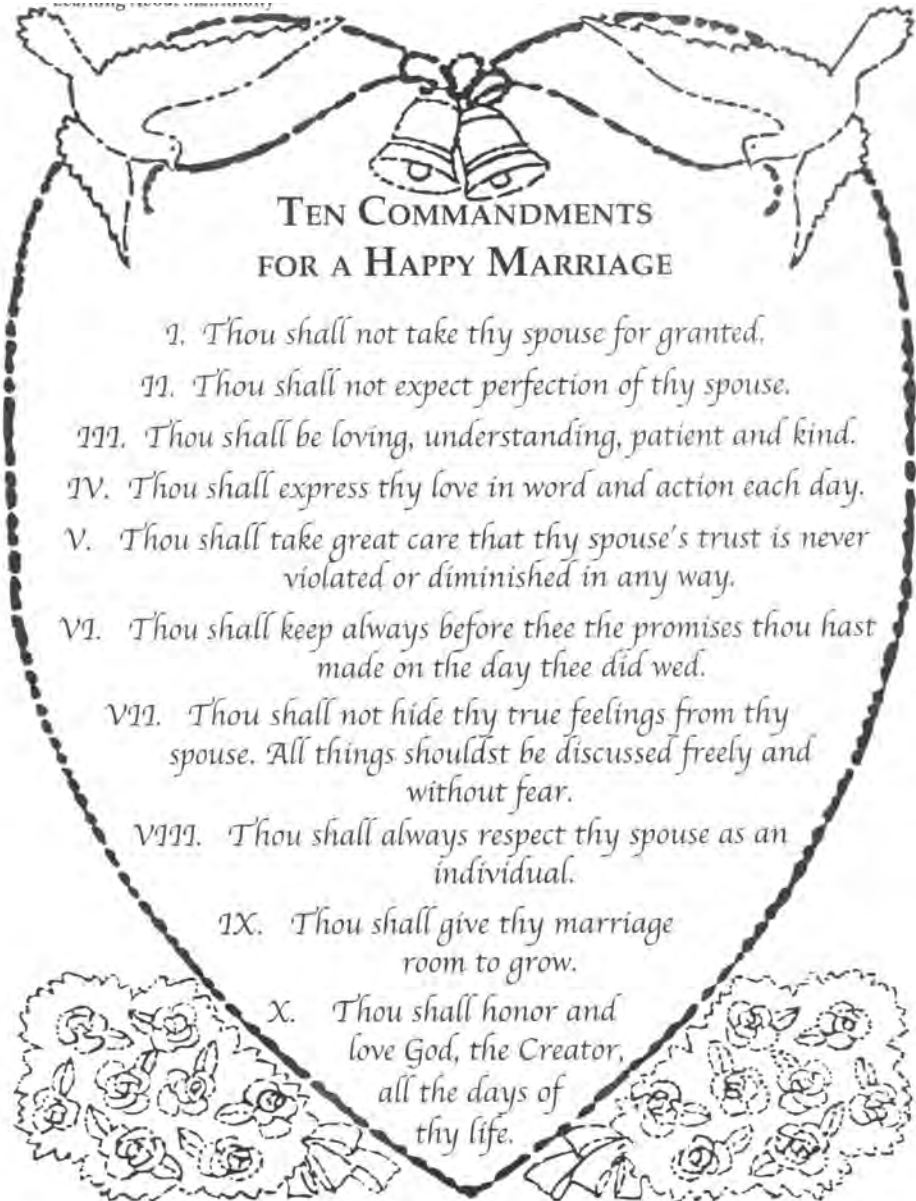

Our journey towards Easter continues. This time we experience a foretaste of the glory of Jesus. The account of the transfiguration begins by giving us the time frame: "About eight days after he said this..." The evangelist Luke refers to Jesus' teaching on discipleship as if to suggest that now we are in the beginning of a 'new time'. We should also take notice that Jesus' transfiguration happens at a time when he was at prayer. We come to understand that the change in Jesus' countenance is an effect of that prayer, a communion with the Father.

Transformation in our lives as disciples of Jesus begins and is sustained by prayer, not only during the Lenten season but always. Prayer is food for the soul. I encourage you to take some time to pray before the Blessed Sacrament every first Friday of the month or better yet an hour a week. Pope Benedict says, "Adoration outside Holy Mass prolongs and intensifies what has taken place in the liturgical celebration and makes a true and profound reception of Christ possible. I warmly recommend, to pastors and to all the faithful, the practice of Eucharistic adoration."

The St. Joseph Parish Collection and the St. Joseph School Collection will remain open.

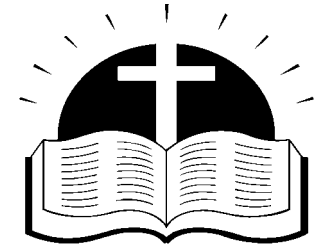
