Dear brothers and sisters,

### Happy Easter!

We have a beautiful canticle recited on Easter Vigil, "Father, even today we see the wonders of the miracles you worked long ago. You once saved a single nation from slavery, and now you offer that salvation to all through baptism. May the peoples of the world become true sons and daughters of Abraham and prove worthy of the heritage of Israel."

Jesus Christ, in his death and resurrection, has freed us from the radical slavery of sin and opened for us the way towards the kingdom of God. This passage takes place first of all within ourselves and it consists in a new birth in the Holy Spirit, the effect of the Baptism that Christ has given us in his Paschal Mystery.

Easter is our true salvation. If Christ, the Lamb of God, had not poured out his blood for us, we would be without hope. As people having emerged from the waters of baptism we are sent out to the whole world to bear witness to this salvation, to bring all people the fruit of Easter, which consists in a new life in communion with God.

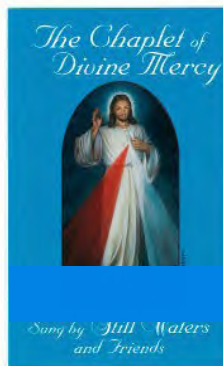

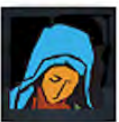
