The peace of mind and soul which this sacrament imparts to us is one for which there is no substitute. It is a peace that flows from a **certainty**, rather than from an unsure hope, that our sins have been forgiven and that we are right with God.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is being offered from 6 to 7 pm each Friday evening during Lent just before Stations of the Cross.

Saturday Reconciliation will continue as usual from 10 to 11 am.

Peace!

In this Sunday's Gospel, we see God's commitment to his people in the very person of Jesus. In the first part of the Gospel, Jesus pronounces stern warnings and refuses to attribute the misfortunes that befell the Galilean pilgrims and the victims of the fall of the tower of Siloam to God, or to God's sense of justice. Jesus wants us out of the situation of sin. Sin is the great misfortune. Sin makes us and others suffer. We should turn away from it.

The second part of the Gospel tells of Jesus' parable and uses the imagery of the vineyard from the book of the Prophet Isaiah. He pictures a God who, despite impending threats, does not give up on people.

We are like Israel who has been barren because of sin. Jesus, the vine-dresser, is giving us an opportunity to repent and produce fruits of conversion. Lent is a time to seize the opportunity to take a fresh look at the promises we made at baptism. It is a time to anchor ourselves back to God.

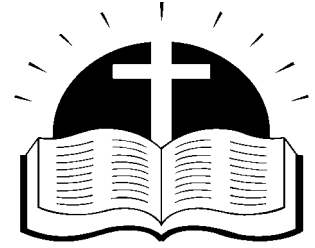
