### Weekly Reflection from Fr. Poli

#### **Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time:**

#### "By your perseverance you will secure your lives!"

As we approach the end of the Liturgical Year, the Church invites us to ponder on the reality of the Four Last Things: death judgment, heaven and hell. But this is not so much as to create fear in our hearts but to encourage us and give us the reason for true hope to take hold of our lives. As Scripture says, *And the world passes away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever* (1 John 2:17).

In the Gospel, Our Lord Jesus used the image of the temple to remind us of the future that awaits us all. The temple is a portrait of passing things. Just as it was in splendor and now is gone, so too everything we see now and admire will pass. This is a sober truth we must come to accept, even if it is difficult. Hence this world is passing and we too are passing from it one day soon. But no reason to be discouraged because it is just to set the stage for that which would last for eternity. But meanwhile, we must be prepared when it finally happens. And we must take care not to be deceived by the voice of the false prophets who sows fear and confusion.

The sign of a true prophetic voice is the hope and confidence they inspire in people. They lead people to hear the true and real word, God's word, which brings encouragement and peace.

Indeed what this means for us is in everyday life is that in the face of real crises especially with persecution in life, it is the peace in our hearts, it is our hope and trust in God, that becomes the seeds of new life.


