## Weekly Reflection from Fr. Poli

#### **Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time:**

"When the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on earth?"

What were you praying for the last time you prayed? Or what are you praying for today?

In this Sunday's gospel, Our Lord Jesus exhorts that a disciple prays with the widow's persistence or better yet with her pure brazenness that springs from faith and confidence in God who listens to our prayer ALL THE TIME!

But this is also our dilemma. We know that God loves us and hears our prayers. But we also have experienced how many times when praying that God seems absent or seems to say NO to our prayers! What then?

Praying with persistence means that we continually place ourselves in God's hands and we just have to trust that those will be the best hands we could ever be. We have that great confidence in God that we allow God, who knows us better than we know ourselves, to answer our prayers in the way that will be best. And that means that sometimes His answer is a Yes to how we expected it will be. But sometimes it is no or at times not now. And still other times God may want us to keep our eyes and ears open for something other than what we are asking for. But it in the midst of all these, Our Lord tells us to never give up in trusting and believing in God. When we persist, then that from that kind of prayer arises hope!

Let us not forget that the question of the Lord at the end is not, "If the Son of man comes", but "When he comes... " Is not Christ himself sufficient ground of confidence. We should pray for the grace so to live that at the journey's end we can say with St. Paul, "I have kept the faith!" (2 Tim. 4:7).




