

“God, have mercy on me, a sinner.”

There are many occasions that bring us to prayer. There are many ways of praying. And while it is meant to be a moment of encounter with God, our prayer, especially how we pray, reveals who we truly are !

Jesus in the parable condemned Pharisee for his self-righteous attitude as reflected in his prayer: “O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity — greedy, dishonest, adulterous.” Obviously, the Pharisee was extolling himself before God. He was in effect saying, he does not need God’s mercy . While the tax collectors on the other hand approached God beating his breast, and pleading “God, have mercy on me, a sinner.” Acknowledging his sinfulness he is throwing himself totally before God’s mercy.

At the end of their prayer, the tax collector “went home justified,” — God had reconciled him to Himself — but not the Pharisee. How true, “The prayer of the lowly pierces the clouds; it does not rest till it reaches its goal.”

To be pleasing to God, we approach Him humbly and lovingly.



In Remembrance...

In the Catholic Church, November 2 is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, also known as All Souls’ Day. On this day and through November, we pray for our deceased loved ones who may yet be waiting to attain the purification necessary to enter the full joy of heaven. We also believe that their prayers may still intercede for us on earth.

On this day in some cultures, families visit the graves of their loved ones to pray and remember. Did you know that St. Joseph Church has its own cemetery? The land was donated to the church by Aiko Apai around 1860. He was buried there in February 1895. Also buried there is St. Joseph’s first pastor, Fr. Charles Pouzot. They are surrounded by many of the first members of our parish.

In their memory, please join us for the annual blessing of the parish cemetery on Saturday, November 2, at 8:30am. The cemetery is located at 485 Waianuenue Avenue and may be reached by going through the Hilo Terrace parking lot.


