



Aloha! We hope that you are all staying at home and remain well.

The rectory office is open from **8 am to noon Monday through Friday.**

Unfortunately we have been forced to temporarily lay off or cut hours for all of our lay staff due to the lack of funds coming in.

The Diocese of Honolulu has applied for the PPP loan through the SBA for every parish and school in the Diocese—these loans would be forgiven as long as the loan proceeds cover the payroll costs/insurance and utilities.

We are waiting to hear whether the loans are approved or not. If approved we will be able to rehire our staff at their previous salary although their job descriptions may need to be temporarily amended.
