

Today's Gospel is often called the Parable of the Sower. But it can very well be the Parable of Hope for the sower, the seed and the soil.

First, it is having hope for the sower, who never gets tired of sowing even if the harvest is not as plentiful as he would have desired. The sower will not give up his faith on the seed nor on the soil that will receive it just as Our Lord will not give up in sowing His life and Love in our world today. He just trusts that something good will spring forth in His sowing!

Second, it is having hope for the seed that is being sown. That within is the miracle of Life just waiting to be born and how true this is in the Word of God that is sown in our life. This Word becomes the foundation to the seeds of peace, truth, love, faith and every good gift there is that will transform our world to how God intended it to be.

And third, it is having hope for the soil, which is the receiver of the seed that was sown the way we receive the Word of God in our lives. It might not be a rich soil now, but with God's Grace and a little cultivation, weeding, and composting it will be ready to receive the seed and yield a harvest of hundred, sixty or thirtyfold.

Let us not despair, There is Hope for all of us.

WHAT TO EXPECT AND WHAT IS EXPECTED!

ARRIVING AT MASS...(arrive no later than 10 minutes before Mass or forfeit your reservation)

UPON ARRIVAL, PLEASE SHOW YOUR RESERVATION CONFIRMATION TO THE FRONT DOOR HOSPITALITY TEAM. SOMEONE WILL ASSIST YOU IN LOCATING YOUR SEAT NUMBER. YOU MUST SANITIZE BEFORE ENTERING.

PLEASE REMAIN IN YOUR SEATS AT ALL TIMES.

MASK TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES

Only exceptions: priest-celebrant while he is speaking, and the lectors/cantors while they are reading/singing, and when you receive Holy Communion.

ALL WHO ATTEND MASS MUST MAINTAIN PROPER PHYSICAL DISTANCING (6 FEET)

HAND SANITIZER WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE ENTRANCE OF THE CHURCH, BUT YOU ARE ASKED TO BRING YOUR OWN AS WELL.

DURING MASS...

- THERE WILL BE NO MISSALETTES IN THE PEWS. YOU ARE FREE TO BRING YOUR OWN, BUT YOU MUST TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU.
- COLLECTION BASKETS WILL NOT BE PASSED YOUR OFFERING MAY BE PLACED IN THE DESIGNATED WOODEN OFFERING BOX AT THE FRONT ENTRANCE.
- THERE WILL BE NO OFFERTORY PROCESSION
- HOLDING HANDS DURING THE LORD'S PRAYER IS NOT ALLOWED
- DURING THE SIGN OF PEACE, YOU MAY SMILE, WAVE, BOW OR SHAKA TO YOUR NEIGHBOR (NO PHYSICAL CONTACT).

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION...

- ONLY THE BODY OF CHRIST WILL BE DISTRIBUTED
- USHERS WILL DIRECT YOU WHEN TO COME OUT OF YOUR PEW TO RECEIVE COMMUNION
- PLEASE MAINTAIN A 6 FOOT PHYSICAL DISTANCE FROM THE PERSON IN FRONT OF YOU; FOLLOW THE MARKINGS ON THE FLOOR
- YOU WILL RECEIVE COMMUNION ON THE HANDS ONLY TO PROTECT YOU, THE MINISTER AND THOSE WHO RECEIVE AFTER YOU.
- WHEN YOU COME FORWARD FOR COMMUNION, WEAR YOUR MASK OR FACE COVERING. WHEN RECEIVING: REMOVE YOUR FACE COVERING WHEN THE USHER INSTRUCTS, FLATTEN YOUR HANDS, CONSUME, COVER YOUR FACE AGAIN THEN RETURN TO YOUR SEAT
- PARISHIONERS IN THE DESIGNATED HANDICAPPED SEATS WILL RECEIVE COMMUNION AFTER ASSEMBLY FROM CLERGY

AFTER MASS...

AT THE CONCLUSION OF MASS, USHERS WILL DISMISS THE ASSEMBLY BY ROWS.

PROCEED DIRECTLY TO YOUR VEHICLE, CONGREGATING ON THE CHURCH LANAI, AND IN THE PARKING LOT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.


