# **Pastor's Corner**

Third Sunday of Advent Dear brothers and sisters,

First of all I would like to thank all our parishioners, especially those who came to participate in our Second Parish Congress. Fr. Mark Alexander gave emphasis on the six strategic goals of the parish to realize our Mission Statement. He also linked them to the Diocesan Road Map. Furthermore, he said that we need to be in harmony and to be more participative as a parish community (the Body of Christ) in order for us to achieve Fullness of Life in Jesus Christ.

This third Sunday of Advent, also called as Gaudete Sunday, we rejoice that Christ is indeed coming soon. So "Be strong! Fear not! Here is your God who comes to save you!" (First Reading).

Let this be our prayer: "O God, who promised that the least one born into the kingdom of God is greater than John the Baptist, fill us with joy as we enter more deeply into the season of Advent. Make us rejoice when we serve you in the home-less, the weary, the poor, the downtrodden, the lonely ... And let us see the light of your glory. Amen.

Last, let me present to you the sub-themes for our 9-day Novena in preparation for the birth of the Lord:

Dec. 16	John the Baptist: "A burning and shining lamp" Wish List: Celebrate Daily Mass especially on Dec. 16–25		
Dec. 17	Jesus: "Heir to the divine promise of David and the Messianic hopes of Israel: Wish List: Offering Mass Intentions for family members who have died.		
Dec. 18	Joseph: "Doing what the angel of the Lord commanded him" Wish List: Extra time for prayer, especially prayer before the Blessed Sacrament		
Dec. 19	Joseph: "Guardian of the Redeemer" Wish List: Doing voluntary work in the Church/Community before Christmas		
Dec. 20	Mary: "Let it happen to me!" Wish List: Choosing one virtue that you wish to grow deeply (honesty, courage, pa- tience, understanding, etc.)		
Dec. 21	Elizabeth: "The joy of presence and companionship" Wish List: Visiting a friend, a sick person, or the elderly.		
Dec. 22	Mary: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord" Wish List: Offering used clothing, blankets, canned goods, noodles, etc.		
Dec. 23	John the Baptist: "A joyful heart that ponders God's graciousness" Wish List: Availing of the Sacrament of Reconciliation		

Dec. 24 Zechariah: "God visits his people" Wish List: Gifting yourself with something (small tokens like t-shirt, perfume, etc) for doing good this Advent
