

Pastor's Corner Third Sunday of Advent, Year B

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in our Lord Jesus Christ!

We are now in the Third Sunday of the season of Advent, which is called GAUDETE SUNDAY. The rose colored/pink vestment that the Priest-Presider uses designates the spirit of joy that we must have in preparing for the three comings of Jesus Christ: the anniversary of the birth of Jesus Christ on Christmas, the Second/Final Coming of the Lord or the PAROUSIA, and His coming in our daily lives through the Sacraments, especially in the Eucharist.

In our Second Reading Saint Paul commands us, "Rejoice always, ... render constant thanks." We are commanded to be joyful because joy is not only a feeling. Joy is a state of mind, a perspective and a decision to focus on the One who is coming, Jesus Christ. He is the source of our joy because he is our inspiration for living, for doing what is right and just.

In the Gospel we hear about John the Baptist. "He came to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him." Testimony! Testify! The light! This is the reason for our rejoicing: in the darkness of our world, there is a light about which to testify! But this light is somehow hidden. As the Gospel says, "There is one among you whom you do not know." This light is mysterious. It is not immediately visible. This is why someone has to testify to it.

Brothers and sisters, the good news is this: testifying to the light shall be a source of our rejoicing; witnessing to our faith shall be the wellspring of our joy. As Christians bearing and baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, we can say, "I rejoice heartily in the Lord; in my God is the joy of my soul. For the Lord has anointed me and sends me to bring glad tidings of the light." Of course, This will entail sharing in the Paschal Mystery of Jesus Christ: suffering, death and the light and joy of the resurrection.

I would like to thank all the catechists for preparing our children for the RE Mass last November 27 and the RCIA coordinators who are preparing our catechumens for their baptism.

Thank you also for our ministers, volunteers and committed parishioners for sharing your time, talents, and treasures to make us all better prepared for the coming of Jesus Christ, our Lord.




Volunteers are being sought to help decorate the Church for Christmas. If you are interested in assisting Fr. Clifford please call the rectory office.
