FEAST OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION—DECEMBER 8 HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, the solemn dogma defined by Blessed Pope Pius IX in 1854. As Our Lady Immaculately Conceived is the patroness of the United States of America, this is a holy day of obligation in the United States.

Through the centuries the Church has become ever more aware that Mary, "full of grace" through God, was redeemed from the moment of her conception. That is what the dogma of the Immaculate Conception confesses, as Blessed Pope Pius IX proclaimed on December 8, 1854: "The most Blessed Virgin Mary was, from the first moment of her conception, by a singular grace and privilege of almighty God and by virtue of the merits of Jesus Christ, Saviour of the human race, preserved immune from all stain of original sin." — *Catechism of the Catholic Church*

Pastor's Corner Second Sunday of Advent, Year B

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

On this Second Sunday of Advent, the Liturgy invites us to focus our attention on Jesus, our Lord and Savior. The Prophet Baruch gives a description of the Messiah who is filled with splendor and grants salvation to all believers. Saint Paul encourages the Philippians that their love

may increase ever more in knowledge and every kind of perception as they prepare for the coming of the Lord. The Gospel describes how John the Baptist laid the foundation for the coming of the Messiah. He proclaimed a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins.

This coming December 8 (Thursday) we will celebrate the Solemn feast of the Immaculate Conception of Mary. This is a HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION. We will have the 7 PM Mass followed by a fellowship with light refreshments. The Church recognizes that God in a most intimate and privileged way preserved Mary from the taint of original sin. This is so that her womb will be a worthy vessel to become the Mother of the Savior of the world. By joining in the liturgy we not only give honor to Mary, we also ask God to make us his worthy children. Just as the parents of Mary opened themselves to God's plan of saving humanity, we too must pay attention to the unfolding plan of God in our lives. Let us ask for the intercession of our Mother that our celebration of the Eucharist during this Advent increase our eagerness for the One who is to come, Jesus.
