

The current Mass translation has been used since the early 1970s and underwent a complete new translation and update over the last 10 years. Approved by the United States bishops and confirmed by the Vatican, the new translation aims to be more faithful to the Latin original texts and more fully express the scriptural foundation of the Liturgy.



What is the R.C.I.A.?

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process whereby those interested in learning about the Catholic faith come together on a weekly basis to learn about the scriptures and the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, and at the same time, to discover where God is present in their lives. The process is designed for those adults and children over the age of seven who are:

Unbaptised

Baptised in another tradition

Baptised Catholic, but with no further religious training or sacraments

Pastor's Corner First Sunday of Advent

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

We begin a new liturgical year. This is an opportune time for all of us to renew ourselves with the truth that we are God's beloved sons and daughters. We are the work of his own hands.

The Prophet Isaiah reminds us that God is like a potter. His hands are constantly dirty. He comes to us in our mess. He sends to us his son Jesus Christ who was born into the messiness of our sins.

Advent is preparation time. We prepare our hearts like clay before the Potter, God. Our hearts have wandered away from him. The Prophet Isaiah tells us that we have become like polluted rags, withered leaves. It is time for us to call upon the Redeemer, the all powerful Potter to fashion us according to his image and likeness.

Let us rejoice once again in our God, the Potter, whose hands are steady and strong, ready to uphold us in his love. We are messy sinners, in need of God to bring us back into his loving presence.

St. Andrew, apostle Feastday: November 30 Patron of Fisherman

Andrew, like his brother Simon Peter, was a fisherman. He became a disciple of the great St. John the Baptist, but when John pointed to Jesus and said, "Behold the Lamb of God!" Andrew understood that Jesus was greater. At once he left John to follow the Divine Master. Jesus knew that Andrew was walking behind him, and turning back, he asked, "what do you seek?" When Andrew answered that he would like to know where Jesus lived, Our Lord replied, "Come and see." Andrew had been only a little time with Jesus when he realized that this was truly the Messiah.

From then on, he chose to follow Jesus. Andrew was thus the first disciple of Christ. Next, Andrew brought his brother Simon (St. Peter) to Jesus and Jesus received him, too, as His disciple. At first the two brothers continued to carry on their fishing trade and family affairs, but later, the Lord called them to stay with Him all the time. He promised to make them fishers of men, and this time, they left their nets for good. It is believed that after Our Lord ascended into Heaven, St. Andrew went to Greece to preach the gospel. He is said to have been put to death on a cross, to which he was tied, not nailed. He lived two days in that state of suffering, still preaching to the people who gathered around their beloved Apostle.
