The St. Joseph's School Country Fair is set for Saturday, October 1, 2011 from 8am-3pm on the SJS High School Grounds.


We are seeking help with the set up and dismantling of booths and tents.

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

Faith comes from listening. We can know God by listening to His Word. Both the Old Testament and the New Testament are replete of striking passages that speak about the importance of listening to God's Word. In the Sacred Scriptures the act of listening to God's Word is intimately linked to obedience. For the Word of God is synonymous with God's Will. Only those who listen and ponder God's Word, like Mary, can see the wisdom of trusting and obeying God's Word.


