Leader: In a world where greed and the desire to dominate and control the earth lurks in the corners of our hearts.

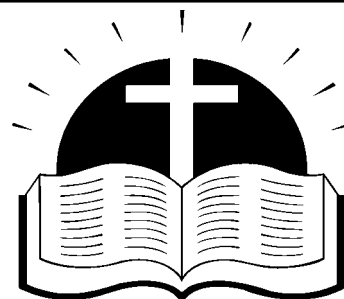
In a world where the earth and the things of the earth have been used and overused for human consumption.
