Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

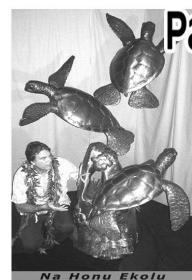

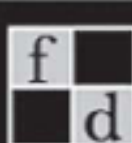
