ALMOST COMPLETE:

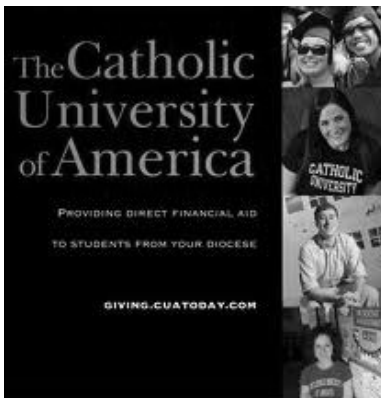
The renovation of our Fellowship Kitchen is almost complete. Many thanks to our maintenance committee who oversaw this project. Special thanks also to our very generous vendors:

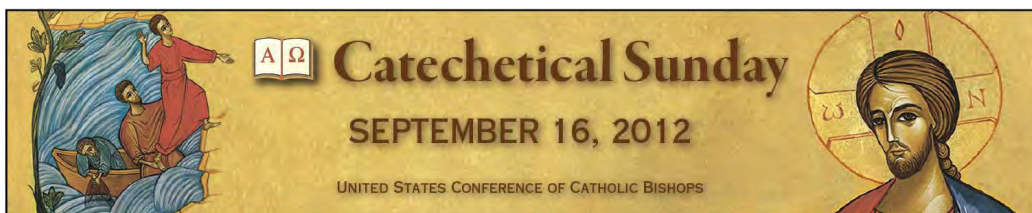
