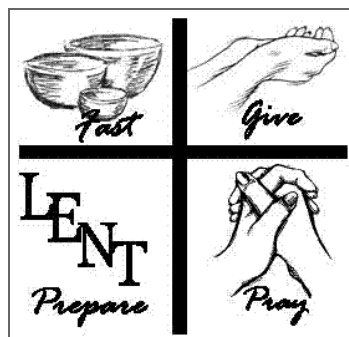

- May 4 - West Hawaii, Annunciation

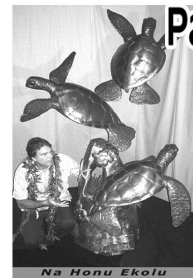
