What Was I Made To Do? Young Adult Speaker Series

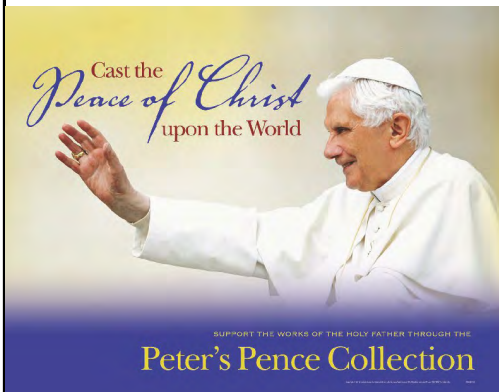
