Today as we observe World Day of Prayer for Vocations, let us be more open and obedient to the directions coming from the Holy Spirit and the Teachings of the Catholic Church.

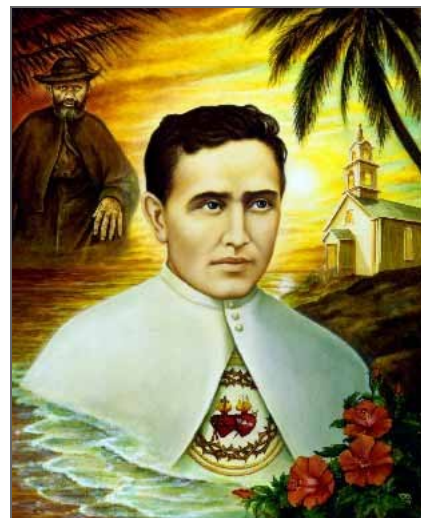
Let us pray.
