


#### **Scripture Readings**

Second Sunday of Lent

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the Lord Jesus Christ!

This Sunday we celebrate the Mystery of the Transfiguration of the Lord Jesus Christ. As the Gospel relates, "His clothes were dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them." That was as far as the three disciples can describe their experience of the physical manifestation of the divinity of the Lord. It was for them a foretaste of the glory of God that they



temporarily forgot about their family and livelihood. They were willing to stay there with Jesus. Nothing and no one else mattered to them.

But Jesus had a mission to accomplish. He reminded the three disciples that they need to go down the mountain of the Transfiguration in order to go to Jerusalem and do the will of the Father. And that event was meant to inspire and give them the courage and the confidence to go through the coming ordeal, the suffering and death of Jesus. Yes, the life of Jesus will not end with his death and burial but with his resurrection, his final victory over sin and death.


