Pastor's Corner

Scripture Readings

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the risen Lord,

Easter is a gift of hope to us who believe. The resurrection of Jesus gives hope to us striving to live good and righteous lives. How do we move from despair to hope?

The story of the two disciples on their Emmaus portrays to us this movement. In their hopelessness, the risen Lord accompanies them. The risen Lord engages them in conversation. The risen Lord allowed them to voice out their despair and frustration. The risen Lord allowed them to tell their story. He listened to them. He is indeed Emmanuel, God-with-us.

Jesus, in the process of accompanying them, explained to them what is contained in the scriptures and the prophets. This resulted in their reaction, "Were not our hearts burning as he explained to us the scriptures?"

Then there is this invitation of the two disciples to invite this stranger, "Stay with us." They have invited Jesus, the risen One, into their hearts especially when they sat together to break bread. In that breaking of bread they recognized that it was the risen Lord in their midst. And that recognition led them to go back to Jerusalem to proclaim what they have witnessed.

The story that began in despair and disarray ended up in hope and joy.
