ST. JOSEPH feast day:

On Wednesday, March 19, 2014 at 9:00 am — SJ School students and faculty will attend a Mass at St. Joseph Church

Also, at 7:00 pm, there will be a Mass for our parishioners to celebrate the feast day of St. Joseph.

St. Joseph has two feast days on the liturgical calendar. The first is March 19—Joseph, the Husband of Mary. The second is May 1—Joseph, the Worker.

"Saint Joseph is a man of great spirit. He is great in faith, not because he speaks his own words, but above all because he listens to the words of the Living God. He listens in silence. And his heart ceaselessly perseveres in the readiness to accept the Truth contained in the word of the Living God," Pope John Paul II had once said. There is very little about the life of Joseph in Scripture but still, we know that he was the chaste husband of Mary, the foster father of Jesus, a carpenter and a man who was not wealthy. We also know that he came from the royal lineage of King David. We can see from his actions in scripture that Joseph was a compassionate man, and obedient to the will of God. He also loved Mary and Jesus and wanted to protect and provide for them. Since Joseph does not appear in Jesus' public life, at his death, or resurrection, many historians believe Joseph had probably died before Jesus entered public ministry. Joseph is the patron of many things, including the universal Church, fathers, the dying and social justice.

Scripture Readings

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace!

This Sunday I would like that each of us reflect on our personal experience, when we have encountered the light of Christ. I hope that when we go back to this experience we will discover the courage that led us to enter the "darkness of self-emptying".

This is the experience of Abram in the first reading. He entered the "darkness of nowhere", clinging on to his faith in God, emptying himself, leaving property, home, relatives and everything comfortable. But in that darkness he became the source of blessing to many.

In the second reading, St. Paul reminds Timothy that the gospel every apostle proclaims brings light. But the bearer of the light must be ready to follow Jesus Christ in bearing sufferings for the truth of the gospel and by dying to self. And in that dying to self he/she becomes an agent of the light of Christ.

Let us be one with the prayer of the psalmist: "Lord, let your mercy be on us, as we place our trust in you."


