

In our gospel episode of the Canaanite woman we hear the cry of all parents on behalf of their children, "Heal my daughter". This woman approached Jesus bearing some faith. She addressed Jesus saying, "Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David!"

As the story unfolds the disciples told Jesus to get rid of her. But Jesus addressed her. And knowing that his mission is for the lost sheep of Israel, He said to her, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs." This foreigner, who was compared to a dog, meaning that she doesn't belong to the house of Israel, persisted. In her helplessness and in her faith she said to Jesus, "Please, Lord, even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters." Her statement disarmed Jesus. He, then affirms the Canaanite woman, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish."
