5th Sunday of Easter

Scripture Readings

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the Risen Lord.

Running through all the readings today is a strong sense of action, of movement *by* the Church and *within* the Church.

In the Gospel of John, Jesus is speaking to the Apostles at the Last Supper. They want to know how to live a righteous life. Jesus responds, *I am the way and the truth and the life*. He is not just the foundation, the cornerstone that Peter writes about in the second reading. Jesus is the path itself. He is the way.

This is a very important truth for our time. Being socially conscious is a common message today. From care for the environment to being conscious about where we shop, our culture is increasingly aware of how our actions affect those around us.

Catholic social teaching helps to express social responsibility and awareness, but Catholic social teaching is different from the humanitarian work of secular society. This is because our work for the poor and our sense of social responsibility must come first from our relationship with Jesus.
