



With Grateful Hearts campaign collects more than \$33 million

The Hawaii Catholic Community Foundation, which manages the money collected through the Diocese of Honolulu's With Grateful Hearts capital campaign, reported that, as of June 30, it has received more than \$33 million of the more than \$50 million originally pledged.

All parishes were required to participate in the With Grateful Hearts campaign.
Parishes receive 25 percent of the funds collected up to its goal. Of the money a parish collects over its goal, it receives half.

St. Joseph was given the following information:

Collected \$ 767,692
Goal \$ 610,000
% of Goal 126%
Amount returned
To Parish \$ 231,346

Funds returned to the Parish were deposited directly into our Diocesan Savings account.

Funds will continue to be collected throughout this fiscal year.


