

Peace!

In our Gospel message today Jesus talks about the greatest commandment.

Quizzed by one of the Pharisees, Jesus does two things. First, he answers their question forthright, showing his affirmation and respect for the Jewish law. Then, with authority, Jesus interprets their most important law, love of God, wedding it to the love of neighbor as ourselves. Jesus knew the importance of this law, taken from Chapter 6 of the Book of Deuteronomy, and known as the Shema, the prayer that was recited twice each day by faithful Jews. Jesus understood that by doing his Father's will and speaking with authority, many powerful religious leaders would oppose him. However, this did not stop him from carrying out the Father's will because of his great love for the Father and his great love for us. Jesus gives us an example to follow. Are we ready?
