Lenten Penance Service—April 9 @ 7:00 pm

When a number of penitents assemble at the same time to receive sacramental absolution, it is fitting that they be prepared for the sacrament by a celebration of the word of God. Those who will receive the sacrament at another time may also take part in the service.

Communal celebration shows more clearly the ecclesial nature of penance. The faithful listen together to the word of God, which proclaims his mercy and invites them to conversion; at the same time they examine the conformity of their lives with that word of God and help each other through common prayer.

If necessary, several priests should be available in suitable places to hear individual confessions and to reconcile the penitents.


Let us deepen our faith in the Lord. Let us ask him to remove the blindness of pride, ignorance and sin in our lives as we do deeds or actions of light.



gram, parents/guardians were asked to read and sign a waiver indicating their decision in allowing their child to receive lessons on Safe Environment. The parish RE program will use the lessons from the curriculum entitled "Circles of Care" recommended to us from the Diocese of Honolulu. This curriculum was developed within the Diocese of Manchester, New Hampshire.

The "policy on Allegations and Incidents of Sexual Misconduct" promulgated by the Diocese of Honolulu is incorporated in the parish handbook by this reference. A copy of the policy is contained in the safe environment document, "To Offer Healing, To Restore Trust," first published January 8, 2004. The document is available at the parish office.

The Church endorses the mandatory reporting provisions of H.R.S. Chapter 350 concerning child abuse. All parish employees and volunteers who have ongoing, unsupervised, direct contact with minors are required to complete background screening and safe environment training in accordance to the policies of the Diocese of Honolulu. 


