


The fee is \$20 per child or a family rate of \$45 for three or more children. New (first-time) families please bring birth certificates and sacramental certificates for each child.

Dear brothers and sisters

Peace!

In the gospel for this Sunday we are told that John the Baptist was just executed by the order of King Herod. His death must have caused Jesus so much distress. He was Jesus' first cousin after all. So the gospel opens with Jesus going to a deserted place by himself. He wanted to be alone. He was grieving.

But we also see that the crowd followed bringing the sick to him. When Jesus saw them, he was moved with pity for them. He abandoned his rest and cured the sick. He got out and opened himself to the needs of others. Jesus made them more important than himself.

Brothers and sisters, let us learn from the "self-giving" of Jesus. Let us give ourselves to those who need our help. Albert Schweitzer, was a French organist, philosopher, theologian, and a medical missionary. He received the 1952 Nobel Peace Prize for his philosophy of "Reverence for Life". He said something important to young people, "I don't know what your destiny will be. But one thing I know, the only ones among you who will be really happy are those who have sought and found how to serve".


