# **Pastor's Corner:**

## 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace!

Jesus gives us two images in today's gospel. He says to the two brothers James and John, "Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?"

In the Book of the Prophet Jeremiah the cup refers to the cup of wrath, the cup of the judgment of God that the people of Israel must drink. Since Israel had sinned against God they are supposed to drink the cup. But instead, it will be Jesus who will drink it to save us.

Another image given is the bath of baptism, the immersion in water. Jesus refers to this as the immersion into the bath of pain, his bloody suffering and death.

Not realizing what they were saying Jesus tells the two, "The cup that I drink you will drink, and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized; but to sit at my right or at my left is not mine to give but is for those for whom it has been prepared."

Brothers and sisters following the Lord will not take away the sufferings and pains we encounter every day. The suffering will still be there. But we are assured that Jesus will be with us. He will accompany us. With Jesus, we can endure any suffering and pain.

Let us continue to pray for our brothers and sisters who are in pain, who are suffering, who find life burdensome. Let us be with them, if not physically, let us be with them in prayer.
