Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace!

We have a shift from Mark's gospel to that of John. This Sunday's gospel focuses on the Bread of Life. This is John's version of the multiplication of the loaves, but with some differences.

A large crowd followed Jesus because they saw how the sick were healed. They ran after him to hear his teaching. They followed to be with him.

Although the crowds did not feel the hunger when they followed, it was Jesus himself who took the initiative of asking Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" And the miracle happened. The crowd ate as much as they wanted. Twelve baskets of leftovers were collected.

Brothers and sisters, we need to have another miracle of the multiplication. We need Jesus to do this for us. But like Philip and Andrew we need to have a new mindset, the mindset of Jesus who alone can provide us of what we truly need as a parish community.

Let us be conscious of our call to stewardship. Let us give our contribution, "our five loaves and two fish" to Jesus. And let us allow Jesus to multiply our offering to him so that all may be benefitted.

As we get ready to present to you the Parish Master Plan

this August 15 during the Parish Congress I ask for your continued prayers and support.
