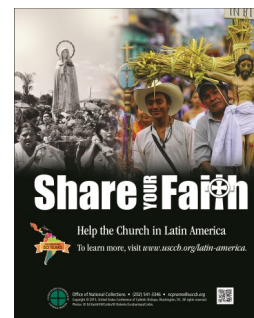


A Stewardship Moment <http://catholicstewardship.com/>
