Weekly Reflections:

Pentecost Sunday – June, 2017 "Receive the Holy Spirit!"

The Gospel this Pentecost Sunday brings us back to the evening of the first Easter Sunday. The apostles were back in the upper room but "the doors were locked." Their hearts were filled with fear - "Fear of the Jews". They have holed up themselves in this room since the Friday Jesus died. Then out of nowhere, Jesus appeared in their midst and after greeting them in peace, breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit." And this was the start of something new for these first community of disciples. The Holy Spirit "filled their hearts and kindle in them the fire of His Love!"

The Holy Spirit works in each of us to help us recognize the hand of God in our lives, to help inspire us, to help us see the blessings we receive. The Spirit gives these gifts because this is what the Father desires and is given in the name of the Son. So, the entire mystery of the Trinity is wrapped up in every gift we receive from the Holy Spirit.

Today as we celebrate Pentecost, is a good time to pause and reflect on the presence of the Spirit in us and the gifts which the Spirit has brought into our lives. What have we done with these gifts? Or probably we might have check the doors of the upper room of our hearts. Have we kept it tightly locked and are hiding our faith where no one can challenge us on it? Today will be a good day, to let the Spirit breathe a new life into our hearts and proclaim the wonder the Lord has done for us!
