



Weekly Reflection: Transfiguration of the Lord 18<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year A

# "His heart was moved with compassion for them..."

A devout businessman is praying with his daughter before she goes to bed. The father says to his daughter, "Let us pray for that poor lady who lives down the street that Our good Lord may come to her aid." His daughter turns to him and said, "But, Dad, we don't need to bother God about that. We can do it ourselves."

In the Gospel this Sunday, we have Jesus "miraculously" multiplying loaves of bread to feed the multitude, who were hungry. The crowd came seeking for Jesus with the hope that He would do something to ease their hungers – hunger for healing, acceptance, love and probably God's words. On seeing them, "his heart was moved with compassion" and knew in his heart he had to do something. Likewise, the disciples saw the hungers of the people, but felt there is nothing that they could do for them but ask Jesus "to dismiss the crowds so that they can go to the villages and buy food for themselves." One reality of man's hunger, but two kind of responding. Which response are we taking?

By the way, the crowd came looking for Jesus, who was in a deserted place. That's how we likewise approach the heart of God; to go searching for him in a deserted place. It all starts with being alone with Jesus in such a deserted place. Where is this place that we could be alone with Jesus? A good place to look into is the depth of one's heart. This is where He would be waiting for us.

And just as Jesus had compassion and fed the hungry crowd, so today he still has pity and still feeds us with Spiritual food in the Eucharist. In the quiet moment of the Eucharist is also where Jesus is definitely waiting for us. Do we want to meet him there?

# THE HOLY FATHER WANTS TO HEAR FROM YOU!

Aloha,

Our Holy Father, Pope Francis recently called a Synod on Young People, the Faith, and Vocational Discernment to take place in October 2018. In January, Pope Francis wrote a Letter to Young People and the Vatican released a Preparatory Document with questions for reflection, and asked the dioceses to answer these questions to prepare for the 2018 Synod.

Pope Francis is asking for feedback from all people, those within the Church as well as non-Catholics, on the experience of young people who are making key choices about life and faith. This Synod process provides a key moment not only for our Church, but also for our diocese. With Pope Francis as a bridge of trust, we hope that this effort to collect feedback will become an evangelizing moment to encounter and accompany a new generation in their journey of faith throughout Catholic parishes. We believe that in order to understand the experience of young people, we will need to not only invite older youth and young adults, but also, parents, adults who work with young people, etc. to share their experience.

To help us do this, we are asking that all parishes/Catholic schools, organizations, and communities to widely distribute the online survey (www.catholichawaii.org/synod2018) to all young people and adults (ie. parents, parish/school staff, ministry leaders, parishioners, etc.). The survey will close on August 21, 2017.
