Weekly Reflection:

20th Sunday of Ordinary Time - Year A "O woman, great is your faith!"

In contrast to last Sunday's reprimand of Peter for being one who has "little faith", this Sunday we hear the Lord affirming the Canaanite woman: "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be done for you as you wish."

A priest once said, that priesthood was the second greatest gift that God has given him. When confronted what is God's greatest gift then for him, he replied: "Faith!" How true that is. What a great gift FAITH is!

But what is faith? Many think it is all about "our belief in a God who exists." But for one who believes and has faith, we know it is more than just knowing that God exists. Faith is placing our trust in God or better yet faith is our readiness to entrust our life to this God who created us out of His great love. And one more thing, Faith is first and foremost a gift that has been offered to us by God, himself. And it is God's joy to give His gifts to each and every one of His beloved children. It is clear He has given the gift of faith to this Canaanite woman, who believe in a God whose love knows no boundaries and does not discriminate. But this woman also knew that her faith must be accompanied by action and she did act on it.

And as it is true for the Canaanite woman, so it is also for each one of us. We all are given grace to believe the good news of salvation through Christ, and hopefully we will open our hearts to the leading of this grace and cooperate with it. Where it will bring us, we really do not know. But we can be certain that being" faithful", can only mean preparing an eternity with Him.

As we thank God for this wonderful gift of Faith, let us also pray for the grace we let it shine in our lives.
