Weekly Reflection: 19th Sunday in ordinary Time Year B – August 12, 2018

If anyone eats this bread he shall live forever

Do you wish to live forever? Well, it depends. If it is a life of perpetual bliss, why not? But if it is a life which is a valley of tears then it will not make sense.

We continue to listen to the bread of life discourse this Sunday. And we hear Jesus make a very controversial claim, ***“I myself am the living bread come down from heaven. If anyone eats this bread he shall live forever; the bread I will give is my flesh for the life of the world”***. Do we wish to eat this bread that Jesus offers so that we might live forever?

When Christ offers Himself as our nourishment, for us, it was not meant to be just a temporary respite to our human hunger. He is meant to be our nourishment for eternal life! And it is eternal not in the sense of quantity or length of time as a quality of life that transcends this physical existence. It is a life live to the fullest because we are sharing it with the Eternal One – God. Hence, life here means being incorporated into Christ and Christ being incorporated in us so that we are enabled to give life to the world and to share in His mission. Then we live forever with Him!

The Eucharist, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, offers us a foretaste of this Living Bread. In the Eucharistic Prayer, we beg that the Holy Spirit makes us one body and one spirit in Christ. Is this not the beginning of life with Christ forever?




Welcome Bishop Julio Angkel!
