

Weekly Reflection: 29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – October 21, 2018

**Whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant**

Who do we consider great in our world today? Those who have their names engraved in the façade of big buildings, or those who have so many 000,000 in their bank accounts, or those whose faces appear in the business magazines.

But the Gospel today has a different standard for greatness. It is the norm of service: “Whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all.” For Our Lord Jesus, service is the way to true greatness. Because when one knows how to serve, one no longer live for oneself alone but for others which is what participation in the Kingdom of God is all about. The good news is that we all have the opportunity to serve and be of service paving the way for all to be great in the eyes of the Lord.

Unfortunately, we have corrupted the word SERVICE. The life of service exemplified by Jesus is one that is total and freely given without expecting anything in return. But today we speak of service in exchange for money one is willing to pay. Or we speak of service this classified as either 1<sup>st</sup> class or 2<sup>nd</sup> class or 3<sup>rd</sup> class. We even call punishment impose to erring individual Community service.

Let us pray for the grace, that we again rediscover the true life of service that we can offer to the Lord.


**Bring the form and a copy of your marriage certificate from the church of marriage to the rectory office by January 15, 2019.**


