## Weekly Reflection: 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter – 2019 (Divine Mercy Sunday)

### “My Lord and My God!”

“The Paschal Mystery (Passion, Death and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus) is the culmination of this revealing and effecting of (Divine) Mercy, and that the paschal Christ is the definitive incarnation of Mercy, its living sign ... (and) its inexhaustible source” (John Paul II, Dives in Misericordia, 8,7).

That is why, the Second Sunday of Easter has been designated as the Divine Mercy Sunday - a feast to celebrate on the Mercy of God which is the reason for His self-giving.

In the Gospel, St. Thomas, the Apostle, sought for proof through the wounds that the Lord had to endure but Jesus made sure that Thomas goes beyond the wounds, He showed him His heart that is the fountain of Mercy for those who believe in Him.

With Thomas, let us humbly cry out: “My Lord and My God!”

## The FEAST of DIVINE MERCY

— 4 KEY POINTS —



### 1 The FEAST of DIVINE MERCY

Saint Faustina Kowalska was a Polish nun who received mystical revelations in which Jesus showed her his heart, the source of mercy and expressed his wish that this feast was celebrated. Therefore, she is known as the messenger of Divine Mercy.



### 3 The FEAST of DIVINE MERCY

In order to celebrate this day, it is recommended to pray the Chaplet and the Novena of the Divine Mercy, go to confession (after a deep examination of conscience), and to receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast of Divine Mercy.



### The FEAST of DIVINE MERCY 2

The Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments issued on May 23, 2000 a decree (at the suggestion of St. John Paul II) in which the feast of Divine Mercy would be celebrated each year on the second Sunday of Easter.



### The FEAST of DIVINE MERCY 4

The main purpose of the Feast of Divine Mercy is to send the entire world an important message: God is merciful and He loves us all.




