- *Class time: 1 1/2 hours (15 minutes before, 1 hour with the class and possibly 15 minutes after dismissal)
- *Meeting time: 1 1/2 hours for catechist meeting (quarterly or semi-annually)
- *Personal formation, continuing education classes: at own discretion

Monday, August 19 at 6pm in the rectory library. All are welcome to join.


