Weekly Reflection: **6th Sunday of Ordinary Time – Year C – 2019**
“Blessed are you...”

Who does not want to be blessed? And this Sunday’s gospel offers us just that: the opportunity to experience God’s blessing as Jesus proclaims in his sermon in the plain. “Blessed are you...”

But then, we are also taken aback when such blessedness is connected to being poor, hungry, grieving and being hated. How can that be? Well, only because we know that God remains committed to keep His promises to be by our side and to take care of us. This makes hope well up in our hearts. And Our Lord’s life is the best witness on “this blessedness”.

Jesus lived a life of poverty and yet was always filled with joy to share whatever he has to others. He experienced what it means to be hungry with his disciples with only grains of wheat to eat and yet he was ready to offer his life as a bread for others. He wept at the death of Lazarus only to bring him back to life. He was hated and persecuted by his enemies but only to pray that God may forgive them for they do not know what they are doing. Jesus was indeed the Blessed One of the Father! And Jesus, himself, would proclaim "I have told you these things so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete."

To choose the way of Jesus, is to embrace the path of blessedness. But to reject him is to walk the path of woes. Which path are you taking?






