Weekly Reflection: 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year C

**“Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.”**

For Jesus everything is linked to the working of the Holy Spirit - his conception, his baptism even his temptation in the desert. It is therefore should not be a surprise that His ministry can be traced likewise to the Holy Spirit as he quoted today the Prophet Isaiah: *“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.”*

And having been baptized in His name and having shared his body and blood in the Eucharist, we too are filled with the same Spirit and therefore called to that same mission of proclaiming the Good News probably not so much by preaching of the word as by the witness of our lives. As such we do not depend on our skills, training and knowledge but on the Spirit. And thus, despite our weaknesses and brokenness we are called to carry out the mission of Jesus in our world today. And then, with the Lord, we can truly say: **“Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.”**






