



**Lord teach us to pray...**

When was the last time you really prayed? And what was your prayer?

The request of the disciples to Jesus: “Lord, teach us to pray...” was brought about by their seeing Jesus in prayer. But like us, the disciples must have been accustomed also to some form of ritual forms of “talking” to God. They, however, must have recognized a difference in the way Jesus prayed. Did they recognized the effects of Jesus’ praying which they did not see in their own way of praying?

This request of the disciples is a good reminder for all of us to assess our own prayer life. First, how is our prayer changing us to the person that God wants us to be and not changing God to the God we want him to be? Second, how does our prayer deepen our relationship with God especially as a loving father who truly cares for us? Thirdly, how does our prayer bring us closer to one another? And finally, prayer is not what we do but what we become – Our whole life becomes a PRAYER!

*As you prepare and teach your lessons, you are sure to grow in faith yourself!*




