Weekly Reflection: **Pentecost Sunday – 2019**

“Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of thy faithful...”

We close the Easter Season with the celebration of the Solemnity of Pentecost. And St. Luke in the Acts of the Apostles gives a detailed account of what transpired that momentous day which is considered the birthday of the Church. The disciples were gathered in fear when they heard a sound like a strong driving wind. Then there was what seemed to be like tongues of fire rest on each of them. Filled with the Holy Spirit, they went out and preached to the crowd. The Holy spirit makes them come forward as prophets, namely, as “called by god to speak for Him.” And with that the Spirit has started the task of giving birth to the Church.

As believers, we received the Holy Spirit when we were baptized. And accordingly received also the gifts we need to fulfill our personal vocation. Discovering these gifts of the Spirit is one of our sacred responsibilities because it is through the use of these gifts that we participate in the proclamation of the Kingdom of God. In the readings today, one such particular gift is the gift of communication, which we can say is the miracle of Pentecost. We are all called to communicate the Good News of Jesus Christ to the world.

Together, let us ask that the Spirit take over our lives and be guided by Him as we pray: “Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of they faithful and enkindle in us the fire of the Divine life.”


Repair, Maintenance & Improvements

Some have asked about the changes in our savings account balances. It is important for us to let everyone know more about your Parish financials.

Designated Funds differ from Restricted Funds. Designated Funds are those reserved at the direction of the Parish Administrator. They can be used for a variety of needs. Restricted Funds are restricted for use by the donor and cannot be used for purposed other than that stated by the donor. Your Parish has been careful to make sure any designated donation is used specifically for the purposes intended.

Our savings have dropped substantially over the past couple months due to year end financial needs of our parish school. The amounts given over the past couple months will be paid back to the parish. Arrangements for repayment are documented. It is also noted that general collections continue to decline and lately we have gone into our designated funds to pay the bills. Nevertheless, the large balance decreases are related to the schools year end needs.




