Weekly Reflection: **4th Sunday of Lent - 2019**

Coming to his senses

The Fourth Sunday of Lent is called the Laetare Sunday or the Sunday of Rejoicing. So, don't be surprised when the vestments change from violet to pink rose to mark the mood. But why rejoice? For one simple reason – the whole Lenten journey is a journey towards our redemption from bondage and to live as true children of God.

And this is what we read in the parable this Sunday. It is the story of two sons who have such a prodigal father. Prodigal because his love for his sons was overflowing to the point of extravagance. But unfortunately, at the beginning both sons failed to recognize this unconditional love of their Father.

We carry parts of the two sons in us the younger one was drawn to the lure of a life of pleasure away from the loving gaze of the father while the older one failed to see the blessing of living in the presence of the father. But like the younger son, let us pray for the grace “to come to our senses” and return to the Father who awaits us, ready with His forgiveness. **Coming to our senses is to remember who we are in the eyes of our loving Father in heaven.**



GROUND NUT STEW

Makes 4-6 servings



- 2 T fair trade olive oil
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1 red pepper, chopped
- 4 tomatoes, diced
- 2 carrots, chopped
- 1 chili pepper, diced
- 2 t salt
- ½ t ground cumin
- ¼ t black pepper
- 3 cups water or vegetable broth, plus more as needed
- ½ c creamy peanut butter
- 2 cups white rice

Heat olive oil in large pot over medium heat. Sauté onion and garlic until brown. Add red pepper, tomatoes, carrots, chili pepper, spices and water/broth. Bring to a boil, then cover and cook on low until veggies are soft. Stir in peanut butter until evenly mixed. Serve over rice.






