"Who do men say that the Son of man is?"

Today we give much importance to one's public image. A good public image can land you in a public office or can be one's passport for a lucrative business or career. In the same way, a tarnished public image can be the cause of one's downfall. But the greater danger is if the public image does not conform to the true self.

So when Jesus, however, asked in the gospel "Who do men say that the Son of man is?", it was not because he was concerned about his public image. It was to get a reality check - whether people have gotten to really know him. And true enough, they got it wrong. For them, He was merely a prophet. For the same reason, He affirmed Peter when he replied: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." This, however, can only come through the inspiration of the Father.

It is always a great temptation to capitalize on public opinions and thus be able to make a great name for ourselves. But Jesus refused to do that. Instead He only desired to be the faithful to the mission entrusted to Him as the Messiah, the anointed One of the Father even if it means embracing the cross.

In the same way, as followers of Christ, we also will be confronted by choices and decisions in life that can either make us popular and famous or make us faithful to our call as a disciple. May we always and only choose the way of Christ!







- . WHEN YOU COME FORWARD FOR COMMUNION, WEAR YOUR MASK OR FACE COVERING. WHEN RECEIVING: REMOVE YOUR FACE COVERING WHEN THE USHER INSTRUCTS, FLATTEN YOUR HANDS, CONSUME, COVER YOUR FACE AGAIN THEN RETURN TO YOUR SEAT
